

TERMS OF SERVICE

1. Acceptance of Terms

By accessing, browsing, or otherwise using any site on domain pamteh.si (the "Website") in any manner, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms of Service (the "Terms") and all applicable laws and regulations.
